WebIncrease or decrease feeding volume by 5-10% based on weight gain Important Considerations Tube fed infants require periodic volume increases for continued growth. Follow these general guidelines for advancing enteral feedings for infants (up to 12 months corrected age): 0-3 months old: increase total volume by 1 ounce every week

Parenteral nutrition (TPN) is needed while enteral feedings are advanced.
