One person may feel very orderly/structured (J) on the inside, yet their outer life looks spontaneous and adaptable (P). Another person may feel very curious and open-ended (P) in their inner world, yet their outer life looks more structured or decided (J). Don't confuse Judging and Perceiving with a person's level of organization.

Reliability means a test produces the same results each time one takes it. So if the MBTI is reliable, an individual should always fall into the same personality type, whether they re-take the test a week later or 20 years later.
